- **Dust-Explosion.org** - Ukrainian initiative to spread education on [combustible dust safety in this region](#).
- **Part 6 OHS Regulation Updates in BC** - Extensive regulations on identifying, assessing and addressing combustible dust hazards [in the Province of British Columbia by WorkSafe BC](#).

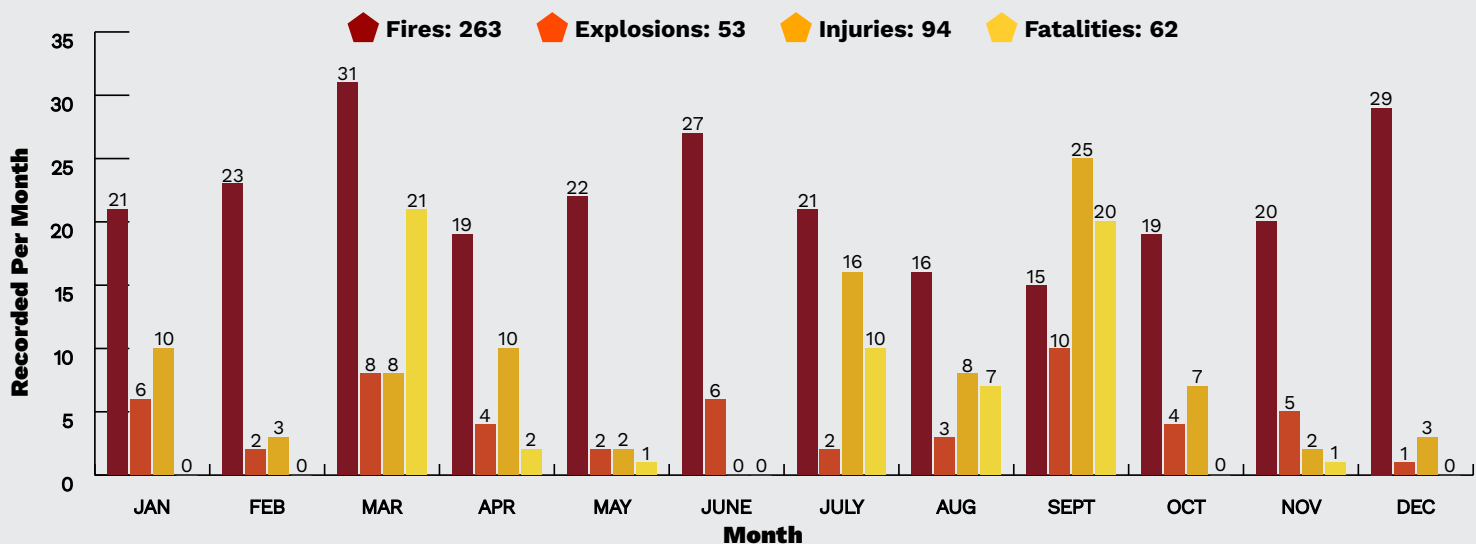

LOSS HISTORY - UNITED STATES

Loss history from dust explosions in the United States over the last eight years is given in the following table. This data has been collected in the incident database and reported in the 2016 to 2023 combustible dust incident reports.

This data gives an average of 28 dust explosions per year, 25 injuries and a range from one to six yearly fatalities over the last eight years. Note that dust fires are excluded in this analysis.

2023 GLOBAL LOSS OVERVIEW

In 2023, 66% of the fatalities recorded occurred due to dust explosions. Of the injuries, 86% occurred due to explosions and 14% occurred due to fires. Some of the more severe incidents include:

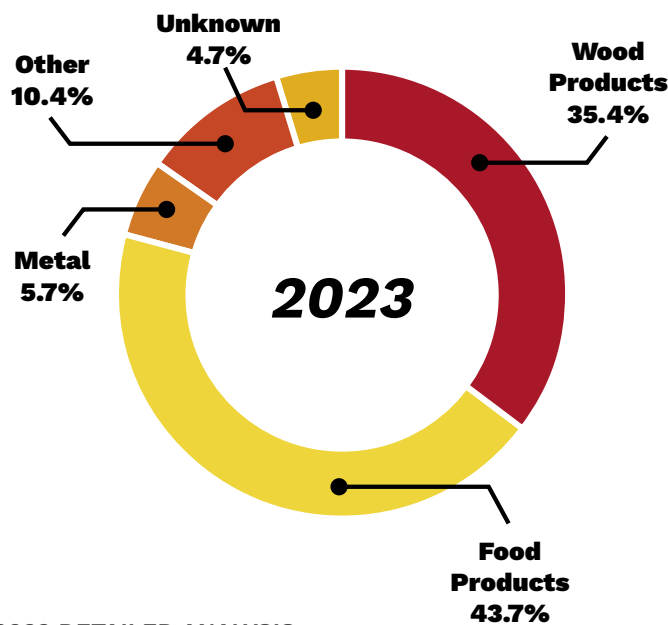
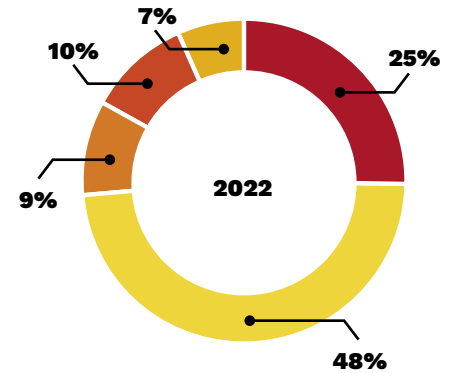
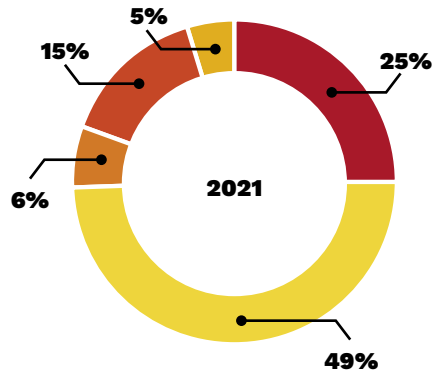
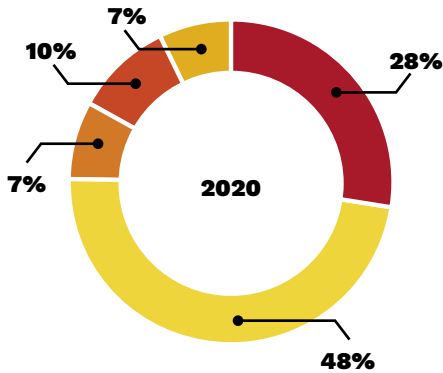

DISCUSSION POINTS

From the global incident data, food and wood products made up 79% of the fires and explosions recorded, 76% of the injuries and 24% of the fatalities. The largest-loss agricultural disaster was a grain dust explosion in Brazil that killed 10 and injured 10 more.

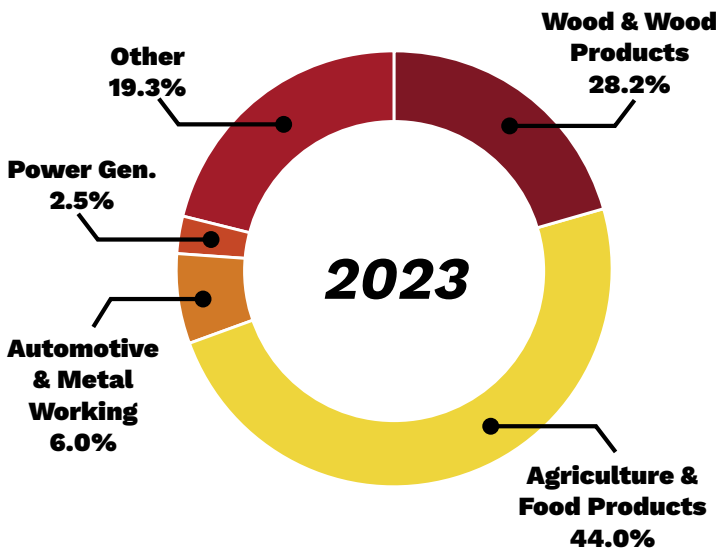
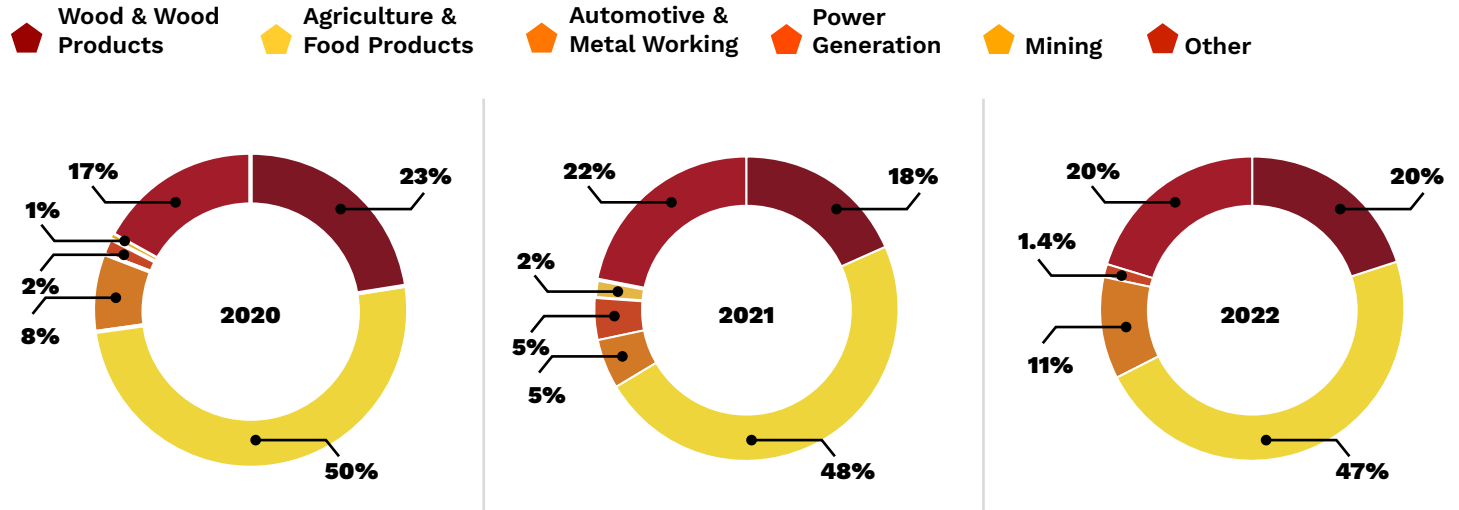
Coal was the most deadly material this year, accounting for 68% of this year’s fatalities, despite accounting for only 3.5% of the recorded incidents. This is largely due to a tragic mine explosion in Sutatausa, Columbia and fires in Panguan, China and Karaganda, Kazakhstan. A breakdown of the fires, explosions, injuries and fatalities for each type of material is given as follows:

Fatal explosions involving metal this year included an aluminum melting furnace in Brazil, and an explosion during a 3D printing dust collector filter exchange in Shanghai, China. A paper products facility fire in Washington and a coal dust explosion in West Virginia contributed one injury each.

Under the category “unknown” and “other”, 4 injuries and one fatality resulted from one explosion at a battery manufacturing plant in Sweden and three fires in a laundry facility, tire manufacturing facility and storage silo fire, respectively.

INDUSTRIES INVOLVED



DISCUSSION POINTS

As shown in the historical data, wood processing, wood products, agricultural activity and food production make up a large portion of the overall fire and explosion incidents. Since 2020 wood and wood products have ranged from 18% to 28% of the incidents, while agricultural activity and food production has ranged from 44% to 50%

As shown in the detailed incident breakdown, the “other” category includes pulp & paper, ethanol, mining, coal handling, high schools, and educational facilities. Industries not broken out in the detailed breakdown include rubber products, chemical processing, plastics and waste treatment.

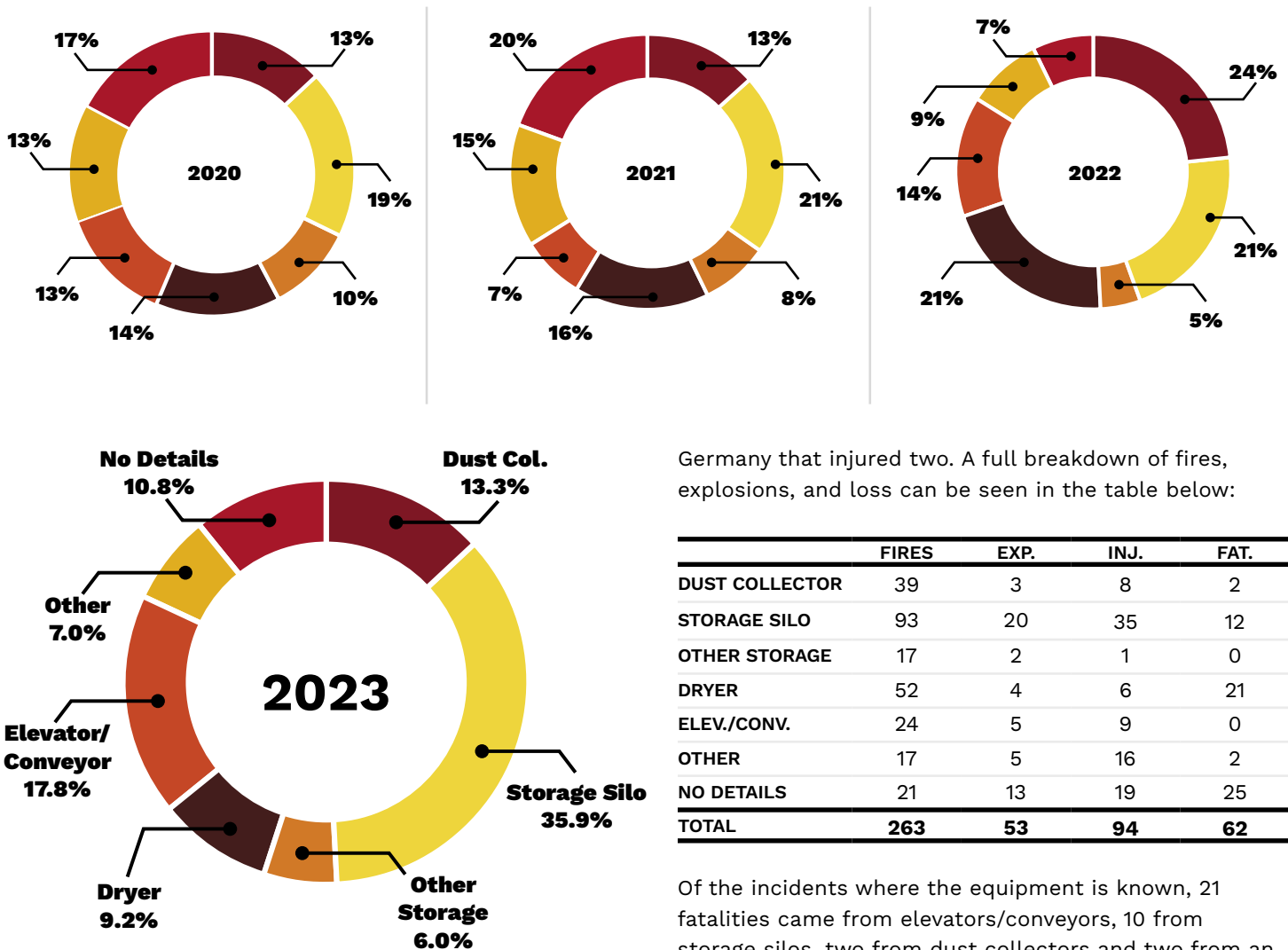

In 2023, mining and industries handling coal made up 68% of the fatalities. Agriculture and food processing made up 62% of the injuries and 22% of the fatalities. Automotive and metalworking made up 18% of the injuries and 3% of the fatalities, while wood & wood products industries made up 11% of the injuries and 2% of the fatalities.

Of the incidents where the equipment is known, 21 fatalities came from elevators/conveyors, 10 from storage silos, two from dust collectors and two from an aluminum melting furnace explosion. The 21 fatalities from conveyor belt systems are attributed to two coal mine fires in Panguan, China and Karaganda, Kazakhstan, respectively.

Incidents where no details were provided for the equipment made up only 11% of the total reported. However, these incidents made up 20% of the reported injuries and 40% of the reported fatalities. These incidents included a coal dust explosion in a mine in Columbia, a sugar facility explosion in Tanzania, a housing materials facility explosion in Japan, a battery manufacturer explosion in Sweden, a grain dust explosion in Decatur, Illinois and a sawdust explosion at a molding manufacturer in the UK.

DISCUSSION POINTS

In 2023, storage silos demonstrated the highest percentage (36%) of combustible dust incidents with 93 fires and 20 explosions reported. Dryers and dust collectors were the next biggest sources of incidents, accounting for 18% and 13% each.

Only three dust collector explosions were recorded in 2023 compared to 10 in 2022. These included a flash fire which occurred during a filter change at a 3D printing facility in Shanghai that killed two workers and injured two more, and a dust collector explosion in Wismar,

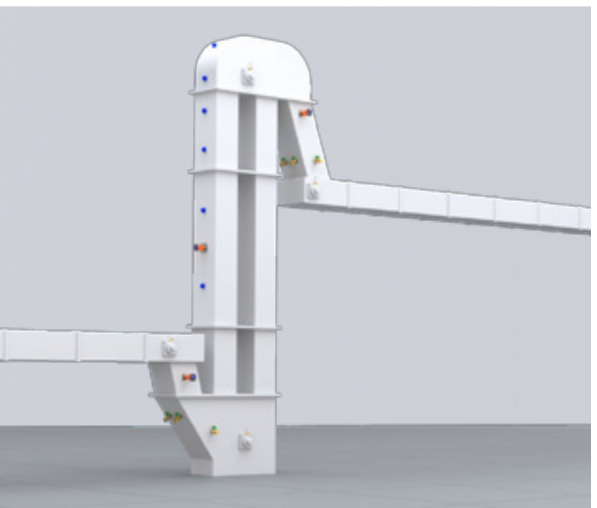
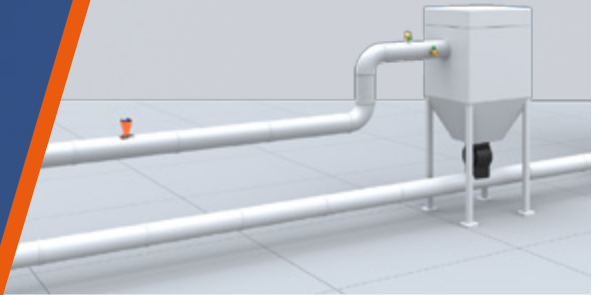

GRAIN DUST EXPLOSION AT GRAIN ELEVATOR IN PARANÁ, BRAZIL

JULY 27, 2023

Ten Killed and Ten Injured

BACKGROUND

The company involved operates in various sectors within Brazil including grains, poultry, swine, and dairy production, as well as other agro-industrial activities.

INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

On July 27, 2023, local news reported a series of explosions at an agricultural cooperative in Palotina, Brazil.

A series of explosions at a grain silo at the cooperative led to the death of at least eight individuals, with one person missing and 11 others injured. Videos circulating on social and traditional media displayed a massive column of white smoke emanating from the location. Residents of Palotina experienced a tremor, with windows in multiple residences shattered by the force of the blast.

A spokesman for the Parana fire brigade explained that the disaster involved a series of explosions, stating, “There was an explosion in one of the silos that triggered a second and a third.”

OUTCOME

This incident has led to increased activity involving combustible dust in Brazil including discussion of regulations and the formulation of the [PCRS group](#) to educate various organizations in the country.

METAL DUST EXPLOSION AT 3D PRINTER PLANT IN SHANGHAI, CHINA

SEPTEMBER 14, 2023

Two Killed and Two Injured

BACKGROUND

The company involved is a laser powder bed fusion technology developer and additive machine manufacturer.

INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

On September 19, 2023, local news reported an explosion at a 3D printing company in Shanghai, China.

At 11:32 a.m., while workers were in the process of swapping the filter of the cartridge dust collector, the initial deflagration occurred. It was reported that the workers sprayed tap water on the dust collector's filter element, which generated hydrogen from the aluminum alloy dust which ignited. No one was injured in this first explosion.

However, at 2:02 pm, upon relocating the dust collector outdoors, workers believed they sensed high-temperature smoke emanating from the filter. When water was poured directly onto the filter element, a reaction ensued due to the high temperature, leading to spontaneous combustion and dust emission. This rapid reaction caused the ensuing deflagration, which fatality injured two workers and caused burns to two more.

OUTCOME

Two workers were killed in the second explosion and two others seriously injured with burn injuries covering 90% and 70% of their bodies respectively.

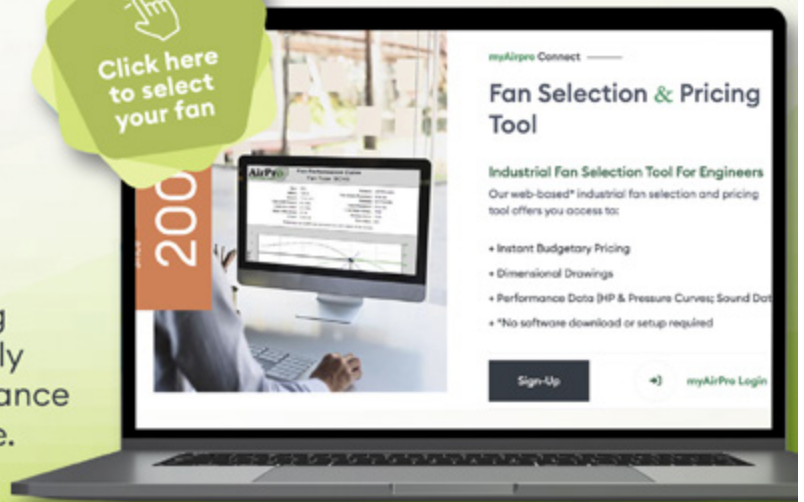

DUST EXPLOSION AT BATTERY MANUFACTURING FACILITY IN SKELLEFTEA, SWEDEN

NOVEMBER 4, 2023

One killed

BACKGROUND

The company involved is a Swedish battery developer, specializing in lithium-ion technology for electric vehicles.

INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

On December 20, 2023 a local industry magazine reported that a worker had died from an explosion at a battery gigafactory in Skelleftea, northern Sweden.

A quote from the organizations director of communications stated: “Formal investigations are underway to determine precisely what led to the accident in November, but our current understanding is that we had a dust explosion in a machine that is not directly a part of the battery manufacturing process.”

OUTCOME

One employee was involved in the explosion incident. He died several weeks later in the hospital due to burn injuries sustained during the explosion.

DUST EXPLOSION AT GRAIN PROCESSING FACILITY IN DECATUR, ILLINOIS

SEPTEMBER 10, 2023

Eight Injured

BACKGROUND

The company involved is one of the world's largest agricultural producers with operations in more than 170 countries around the world.

INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

On September 10, 2023 local news reported an explosion at a grain processing plant in Decatur, Illinois.

The explosion occurred at the East Plant at 7:11 p.m. Nearby residents reported feeling the impact. One man said that it rattled his house. When he stepped outside, he saw smoke filling the skyline. The company promptly contacted the Decatur Fire Department. Upon their arrival, firefighters found numerous injured workers and considerable damage to several buildings. Debris was scattered over a wide area, with fires raging in a 10-story building.

It has been reported that the facility involved had experienced at least three dust explosions since 2018 and multiple fires at the site.

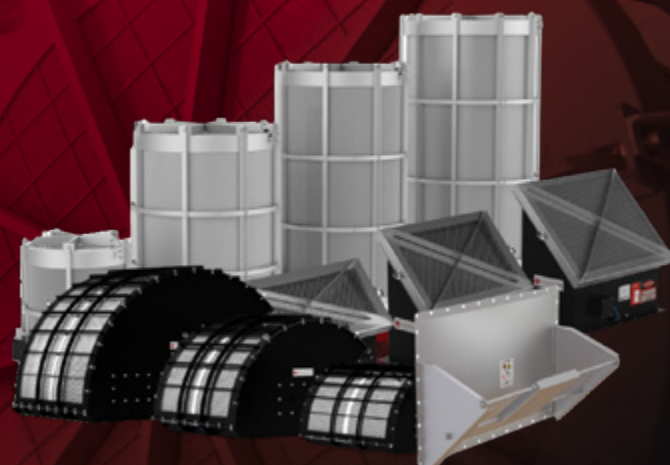
OUTCOME

Eight employees suffered injuries and were taken to local hospitals. Six were transported from the scene by ambulance. Five of them remained hospitalized. One suffered second- and third-degree burns and was later transported to a trauma burn unit.
